## DEFINITION OF SHADING

"Shading" (V-Shade) refers to visible, different shifts in tone in the appearance of a single ceramic tile, or tiles of the same colour.

A number of classes have been identified, into which the various Mirage collections of porcelain stoneware tiles are classified:
V1 = uniform
V2 $=$ slight shading
V3 = moderate shading
V4 = strong shading

Also in the Mirage catalogue, some collections feature medium-strong shading (V3 and V4), in order to represent the actual veining pattern of a number of natural references in the catalogue, while other collections feature almost uniform colour (V1 and V2).
